2.A. Results of environmental scan information for program	□х		Data from a Student Satisfaction Survey was presented to ask students directly about their OSD services experience in Fall 2019. Additionally, they presented data from the Faculty/Staff Satisfaction Survey, highlighting their awareness of services and general feedback on service outreach.
2.B. Analysis of program review data	□х		The report substantiated strengths, weaknesses, opportunities for growth with the data. Relevant demographic information is included, identifying students' goals and comparing their goals to the rest of the campus. Additionally, the report goes a step further and analyzes success and retention rates by primary disability to plan which student groups might need high touch contact for information and services. Dr. Lucero and his staff have performed extensive data collection and analysis, and have a clear statistical picture of their performance and needs.

			they have adopted three new OOs relating to self-advocacy, connections between academic adjustments and their disability, and how it related to reaching their educational goal. It appears to be an effective way of reaching out and connecting students to their academic goals.
