Ms. Charlie called the meeting to order at 3:05 pm. She welcomed and thanked everyone for coming. Ms. Cynthia Kincaid was also in attendance. Mrs. Lowry will be absent for today's meeting.

# 1. Approval of Agenda

Ms. Charlie pulled items 6A and 6B, DM 133 and DM 133L from today's agenda noting that they will come back as revised courses at the next meeting. In its place we will read item #10, the new Distance Education MATH 115 course. The instructor, Mr. Luis Enriquez, could not be here to present his course; however, Mr. Tooraj Gordi will present it for him and inform him of all changes and requests. It was moved and seconded to approve the agenda with these minor changes. The motion carried unanimously.

# 2. Approval of Minutes from October 23, 2008

There were no problems or concerns with the minutes from October 23, 2008. It was moved and seconded to approve the minutes from October 23, 2008. The motion carried unanimously.

# 3. Graduation Proficiency Reading Requirement – Discussion

Discussion took place about the Graduation Proficiency Reading Requirement memo from October 23, 2008 to raise the Graduation Proficiency Reading Requirement to Eligibility for College Level Reading (AVC assessment) or Completion of READ 099 with a satisfactory grade of "C" or "P" (Pass). Ms. Beverly Beyer reported that the Business, Computer Studies and Economic Development division was unanimously in favor. Ms. Linda Harmon reported that Health Science voted yes. Dr. Newman and Mr. Gordi reported that Math, Science and Engineering were all in favor. Mr. Lee reported that Institutional Research is all in favor. Dr. De' Nean Coleman-Carew reported that the Counseling Division is all in favor. We will keep this item on the December agenda for further discussion and then as an action item in February. Ms. Charlie stated that at the State Senate Plenary there was talk of adding a required reading proficiency for all community colleges. We are among the few that already have this requirement.

#### 4. Syllabus Guidelines - Discussion

Discussion took place about the syllabus guidelines for the time faculty have to get a syllabus to their students. Math, Science and Engineering voted for it to be by the first meeting. Counseling also voted for it to be by the first meeting. Dr. Cooper suggested that it be no later than the second meeting. The three options are the first week, the second week, or by the second meeting. This will come back on December 11 for action.

5. Eliminating Instructor Materials Fee – GEOG 205 for Spring 2009 (E-mail Nov 5, 08) It was moved and seconded to remove the Instructor Materials Fee from GEOG 205 and GEOG 222, CRNs 34188 and 32688 starting Spring '09. This needs to be effective Spring '09 due to faulty printer/equipment. The motion carried unanimously. We still need to follow up with the paperwork from the division to officially remove these fees from these courses.

- 9. Revised Courses/CORs First Reading (For items 9*a-r* the discipline designation is changing from CG/MM to DM Computer Graphics/Multimedia to Digital Media.)

The Digital Media courses are creating a new discipline designation, which is replacing both the current Computer Graphics and Multimedia disciplines. Each of the lecture courses presented are moving from 6-hour lecture/lab to 4-hour lecture only. Each of the supplemental learning labs presented will be .5 units with 24 hours total for the student. Ms. Charlie asked Ms. Kincaid provide us with an updated crosswalk, including the labs and any changes made at the meeting. Ms. Charlie stated that all of the certificates are changing and she reminded Ms. Kincaid to revise the certificate pages showing revised courses and the supplemental labs including the increased/revised number of units. Ms. Kincaid noted that Mr. Terry Rezek has 3 more certificates coming to the committee next week. Ms. Charlie reminded the committee that each course will carry the "formerly..." reference statement in the college catalog. All Digital Media courses will be effective fall 2009. All CG/MM courses will be in effect through the summer 2009.

Discussion took place regarding many of the following lecture courses about the need to mention MacIntosh Operating System and Adobe Photoshop specifically; couldn't the courses be taught using Windows/IBM compatible systems and other software choices? Ms. Kincaid explained that these programs are the preferred industry-standard choice (approximately 80% of the industry uses MacIntosh). The committee agreed to keep the references as they are. Also questioned was the change in the prerequisite of CG 101/MM 101 to an advisory of DM 101. It was explained that they are trying to remove barriers and make it easier for students to get into these courses without having to do a prerequisite challenge form, etc. Ms. Kincaid explained that many of the students enrolling in this program already have Photoshop experience. Ms. Beyer asked if students (for example, her advertising students) would be okay if their experience was PC or MS word instead. Ms. Kincaid indicated that the average student would probably be able to learn the basics quickly enough to be successful. Also, all of the requested class maximum changes described below are being withdrawn at this time due to budget constraints.

Ms. Drake also suggested that there be a plan/strategy for accommodating those students who are currently working through the CG/MM certificates/degree programs so that they will not be deficient in units required upon graduation due to the change in the units for these lecture courses from 6 hours to 4 hours. There should be exceptions and accommodations made for these students throughout this transition, which Ms. Drake explained could last for some length of time. Ms. Drake explained that this should be worked out at the division level with the dean and shared with counselors and Admissions and Records staff.

Also, each of the above supplemental learning lab courses will contain the "This is a P/NP only course" statement at the end of the course description.

DM 203 lecture course added an advisory of Completion of DM 101, which is automatically carried on its supplemental lab course. Also, the wording on Course objective #7 was changed slightly by dropping off the words "and definitions".

DM 205 changed the prerequisite of completion of CG 101/MM 101 to an advisory of completion of DM 101. Also noted for DM 205 was that the textbook "Creative Illustration," dated 1947 and others of this kind are considered *classics* and are okay to use.

DM 213 is removing the advisories of ART 110 and ENGL 101 and adding the advisory of completion of DM 101.

It was moved and seconded to approve these courses (a-n) with corrections. The motion carried unanimously. It was moved and seconded to approve the content reviews for these courses. The motion carried unanimously.

DM 233 and 233L: Course number changes are being recommended as noted above. (Page 8 and page 10 of CPF forms and the COR pages for both lecture and lab needs to be filled out and corrected including indicating changes in course number references.) The R3 needs to be corrected to the current R2. These courses will come back for a second reading.

(Note: the following CG and MM courses (q and r) are not cross-listed courses, and both are going to be made obsolete and replaced by DM 246 and DM 246L.)

q. CG 246 – Portfolios and Job Search Planning 3 units, 6 hours weekly

Prerequisite: Completion of CG 101/MM 101 Corequisite: Concurrent enrollment in CG 246L

Advisory: Students should have completed at least four courses in the Computer Graphics or

Photography/Photographic Imaging category.

MM 230 – Multimedia Portfolios and Job Search Planning 3 units, 6 hours weekly

Prerequisite: Completion of MM 101/CG 101 Corequisite: Concurrent enrollment in MM 230L

Advisory: Completion of ART 110, and Eligibility for READ 099. Students should have completed at least four courses in the Multimedia instructional program.

Prerequisite: Students must have completed at least four courses in the Digital Media area. (Must list courses by #)

Corequisite: Concurrent enrollment in DM 246L

Removing advisories of ART 110 and READ 099 (from MM course)

Class Size: request to reduce to 20

Lecture/Lab to Lecture only

r. CG 246L – Portfolios and Job Search Planning Lab .5 unit, 1.8 hours weekly

Corequisite: Concurrent enrollment in CG 246

And

MM 230L – Multimedia Portfolios and Job Search Planning Lab .5 unit, 1.8 hours weekly

Corequisite: Concurrent enrollment in MM 230

Revised to:

DM 246L - Portfolio and Job Search Lab .5 unit, 24 hours total

Corequisite: Concurrent enrollment in DM 246

P/NP only

Ms. Kincaid presented these course outline revisions which replace both CG 246/L and MM 230/L courses. The lecture course includes changes in course description, objectives, content, name, and number. It also establishes typical assignments and methods of evaluation. The prerequisite of MM 101/CG 101 was removed as well as MM 230's advisory of ART 110. Discussion took place about the proposed prerequisite. It was suggested that the prerequisite requiring the completion of at least four courses in the Digital Media area possibly be changed to a statement in the course description making clear what the special expectations and requirements of this course are. Ms. Drake offered to give Ms. Kincaid examples of wording for this statement. The only change requested for the lab course was addition of the P/NP statement. These courses will come back for a second reading.

#### 10. New Distance Education Courses – First Reading

a. MATH 115 – Statistics 4 units, 4 hours weekly – new online equivalent

Mr. Tooraj Gordi presented this new Distance Education math course. All references to the "Blackboard" system should be changed to "AVC's course management system." Ms. Beverly Beyer pointed out that the last statement for item #3, technological adaptations and how they comply with accessibility issues is too broad as written. This course will come back for a second reading.

## 11. Obsolete Courses – First Review

a. PE 235 – Intercollegiate Women's Golf 2 units, 10 hours weekly

(The following courses are being made obsolete because they were changed / revised into PHTC courses.)

- b. PHOT 101 Photography 3 units, 6 hours weekly

- d. PHOT 201 Advanced Photography 3 units, 6 hours weekly With Dr. Grishman's approval, it was moved and seconded to approve each of these obsolete courses, a-d, on the first review. The motion carried unanimously.

Ms. Charlie announced that CAN numbers have all been pulled and are being deleted from all college catalogs and other publications statewide. We will pull all CAN number references from our next catalog and other publications.
