HANDICAPPED PARKING

AVC has handicapped parking available for students who possess the DMV placard or who have handicapped license plates. Students will still need to purchase a semester parking pass, or a daily parking permit to park on our campus. You are permitted to park in the blue handicapped parking spaces or green staff parking spaces. Remember that you must display the student parking permit, along with your handicapped placard to park in handicapped or staff parking spaces. OSD does have DMV forms you can take to your doctor so you can obtain the placard.

The following are California state regulations regarding handicapped parking for community colleges. They are from paragraph (d), Section 54100, Subchapter 2, Chapter 5 of Division VI of Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations:

54100. Parking for Students with Disabilities

- (d) Students with disabilities may be required to pay parking permit fees imposed pursuant to Education Code Section 72247. Students with disabilities shall not be required to pay any other charge, or be subjected to any time limitation or other restriction not specified herein, when parking in any of the following areas:
- 1) any restricted zone described in subdivision (e) of Section 21458 of the Vehicle Code;
- 2) any street upon which preferential parking privileges and height limits have been given pursuant to Section 22507 of the Vehicle Code;
- 3) any parking zone that is restricted as to the length of time parking is permitted as indicated by a sign erected pursuant to a local ordinance;
- 4) any metered zone; or
- 5) any space in any lot or are otherwise designated for use by faculty, staff, administrators, or visitors.
