Who are we looking for?

Students and parents who are motivated to begin and support a college education while attending high school.

Students for SOAR High School will be recruited from eighth grade students in 30 regional middle schools and nine comprehensive high schools. The targeted population will consist of current 8th and 9th grade students with one or more of the following characteristics:

- low socioeconomic status;
- first generation college-going youth;
- underrepresented students; and
- students underperforming in the traditional setting who have the potential to be successful and to become productive citizens.

Objective Criteria:

- Completed application by family
- Most recent (7th grade or 8th grade) California state scores (Baseline – Basic level or above in Language Arts and Math)
- 8th or 9th grade report card – first and second progress reports (Baseline – 8th grade- 2.00 GPA; 9th grade - 3.00 GPA)
- Parent and student interview
- Prior educational experience (full attendance, discipline, etc.)
- Recommendation from the middle school or high school
