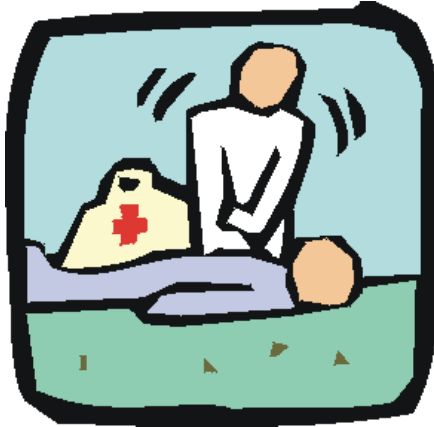

Recognition of Cardiac and Respiratory Emergencies (CPR)



Registered nursing faculty Elizabeth Sundberg (MN, UCLA),

offer this hands-on CPR course.

- Students will develop the necessary skills to perform CPR.
- Each student will have their own adult and baby mannequin, ambu-bag and personal resuscitation device to use during class.

Topics will include: basic anatomy and physiology of the heart, recognition of signs and symptoms of myocardial infarction, airway obstruction, sudden death, and an emphasis on basic life-support measures. This is an American Heart Association CPR course.
