A. Background

Antelope Valley College applied for funding from the Workforce Investment Act Funds for Allied Health Programs to support the start-up costs for the radiologic technology program. The college has been awarded \$128,728 for the first year to fund full-time and part-time instruction and student success strategies.


B. Budget Implications

The award for January 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010, is \$128,728. Additional funding is possible for July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2012.


C. Recommendation
