SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO 2009/2010 LOCAL AGREEMENT FOR CHILD DEVELOPMENT SERVICES – STATE PRESCHOOL PROGRAM

A. BACKGROUND

This amendment to the local agreement includes changes to the service requirements for the minimum Child Days of Enrollment (CDE) by deleting 11,352.6 and inserting 13,272.0 in place. The amendment also includes changes in the Maximum Reimbursable Amount (MRA) (Attachment A).


B. BUDGET IMPLICATIONS

Minimum Days of Operation (MDO) Requirement shall be 242. (No change)
