SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO CalWORKs WORK STUDY CONTRACT BETWEEN ANTELOPE VALLEY COLLEGE AND THE SOUTH BAY WORKFORCE INVESTMENT BOARD

A. BACKGROUND

An agreement between AVC and the South Bay Workforce Investment Board (SBWIB) in Hawthorne to subsidize the cost of CalWORKs students off-campus work study positions through June 30, 2010 was approved in December 2009.

Amendment No. 1 (Attachment A) extends this agreement through September 30, 2010. It also contains a provision to continue this contract through September 30, 2011, if additional funds become available.

AMENDMENT TO CalWORKS WORK STUDY CONTRACT BETWEEN ANTELOPE VALLEY COLLEGE AND THE SOUTH BAY WORKFORCE INVESTMENT BOARD May 10, 2010

**Amendment No. 1
to the
California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (CalWORKs)
Greater Avenues for Independence (GAIN)
Work Experience/Workstudy Combined Agreement
Agreement No. 10-H129**

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into this 1st day of July 2010, between the City of Hawthorne, a municipal corporation, by its Job Training & Development Department on behalf of the South Bay Workforce Investment Board, hereinafter referred to as "City" and the **Antelope Valley Community College District**, hereinafter referred to as "Contractor."

Reference is being made to the document entitled "California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (CalWORKs) Greater Avenues for Independence (GAIN) Work Experience/Community Service Combined Agreement" and further identified as City of Hawthorne Agreement Number 10-H129.

Effective upon the date of its execution, the above-described agreement is hereby amended, as follows:

1. I. General Provisions subparagraph B. "Term of Agreement" is hereby deleted and is replaced with the following language:

The term of this agreement shall be effective from the date of its execution through September 30, 2010. Additionally, in the event of the extension of funding from the Los Angeles County Department of Public Social Services for the Work Experience/Workstudy programs under the Transitional Subsidized Employment Program, the term of this agreement shall be automatically extended from October 1, 2010 until September 30, 2011. Both parties shall perform and complete services for those activities covered by this subcontract until this subcontract expires or is terminated in writing by either party.

2. Section IV, TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT: The statement "this agreement shall terminate on June 30, 2010 unless otherwise modified" is removed in its entirety. Subsections A & B shall remain as written.

3. Section II COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS, Subsection E is hereby amended to include the following:

8. In the event that participants are under 18 years of age, the SUBCONTRACTOR shall comply with Federal and State Labor Laws pertaining to the employment of said participants.

Except as amended herein, all terms and conditions of Agreement No 10-H129 shall remain in full force and effect.
