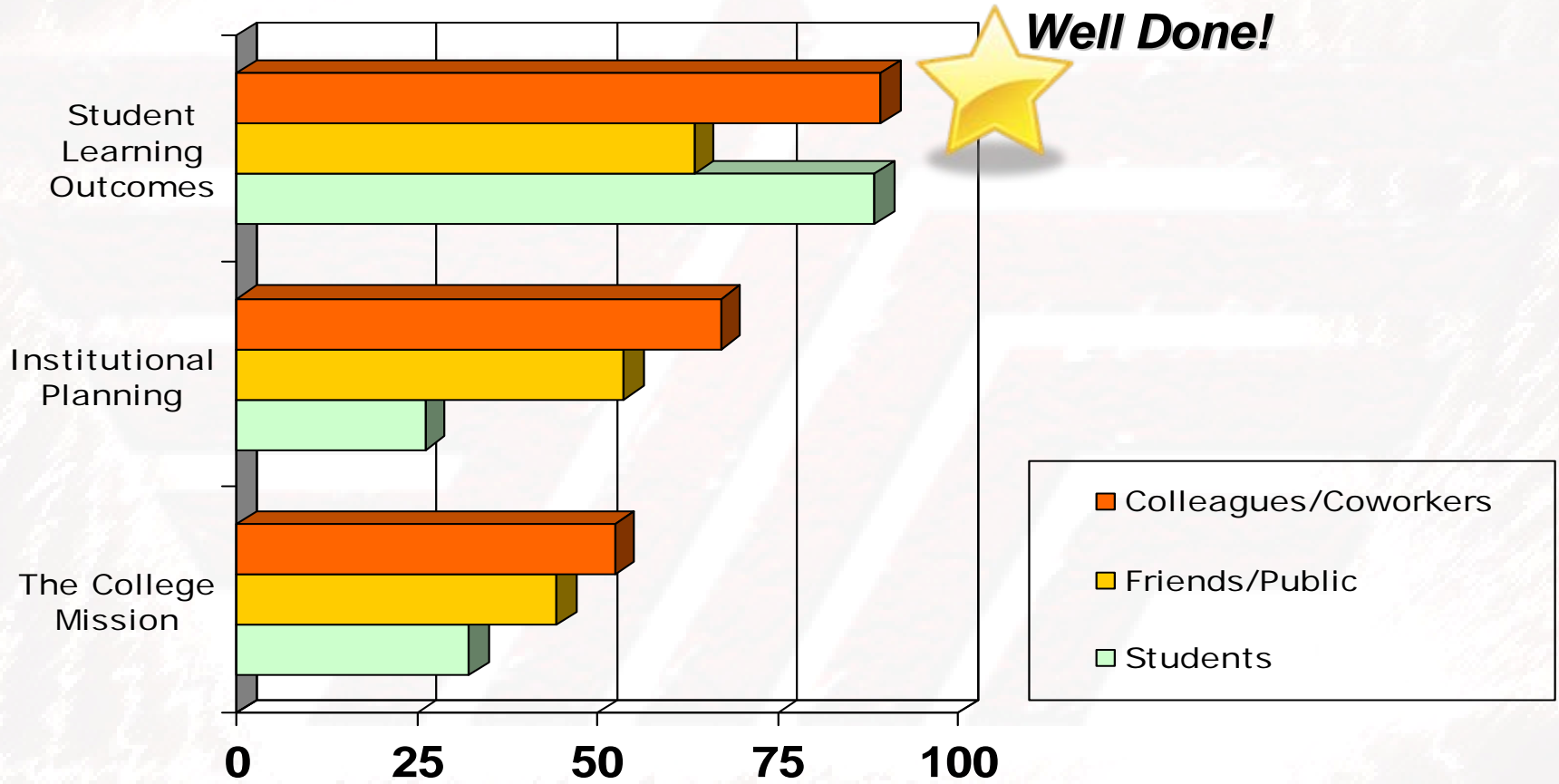

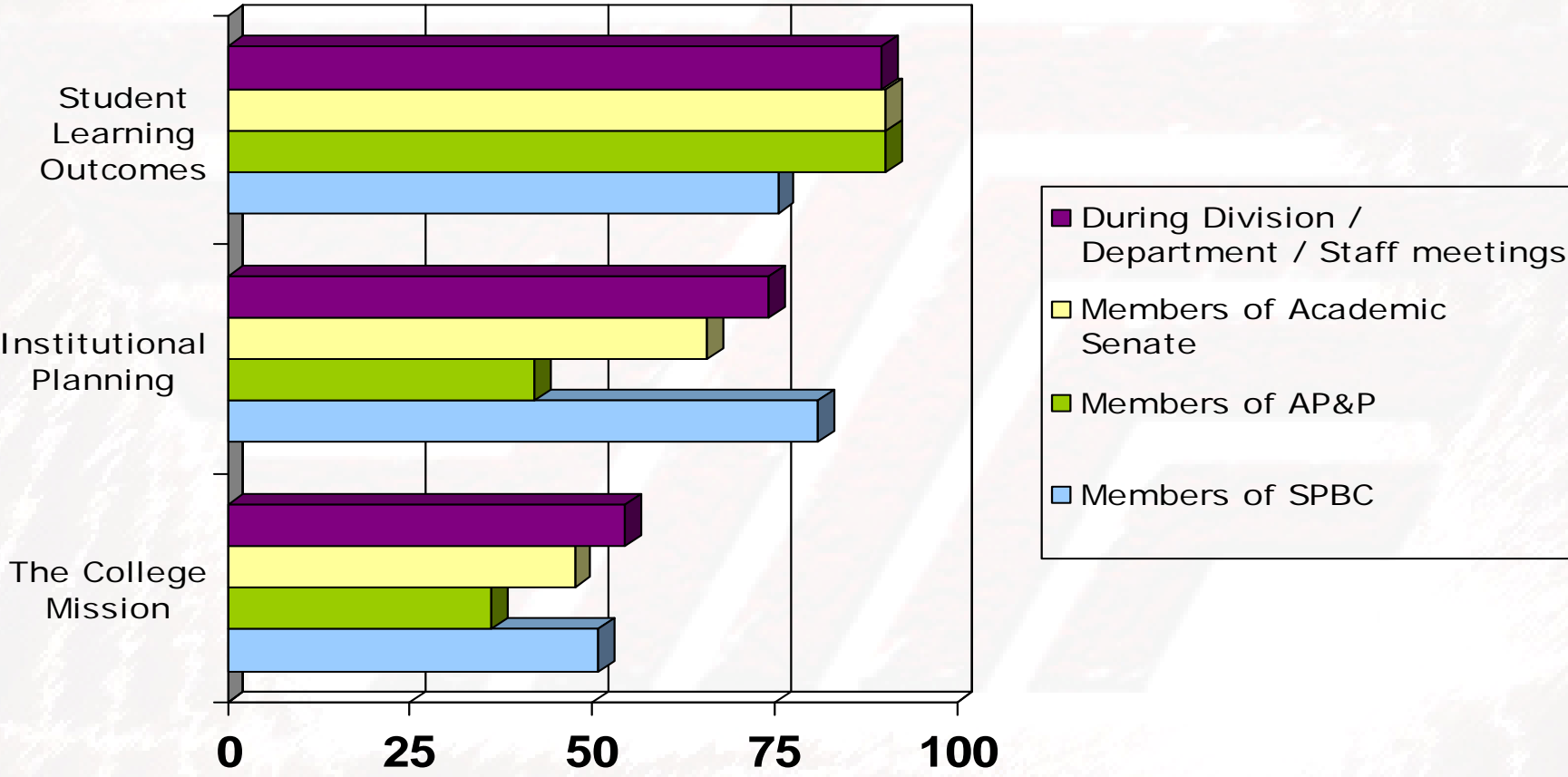

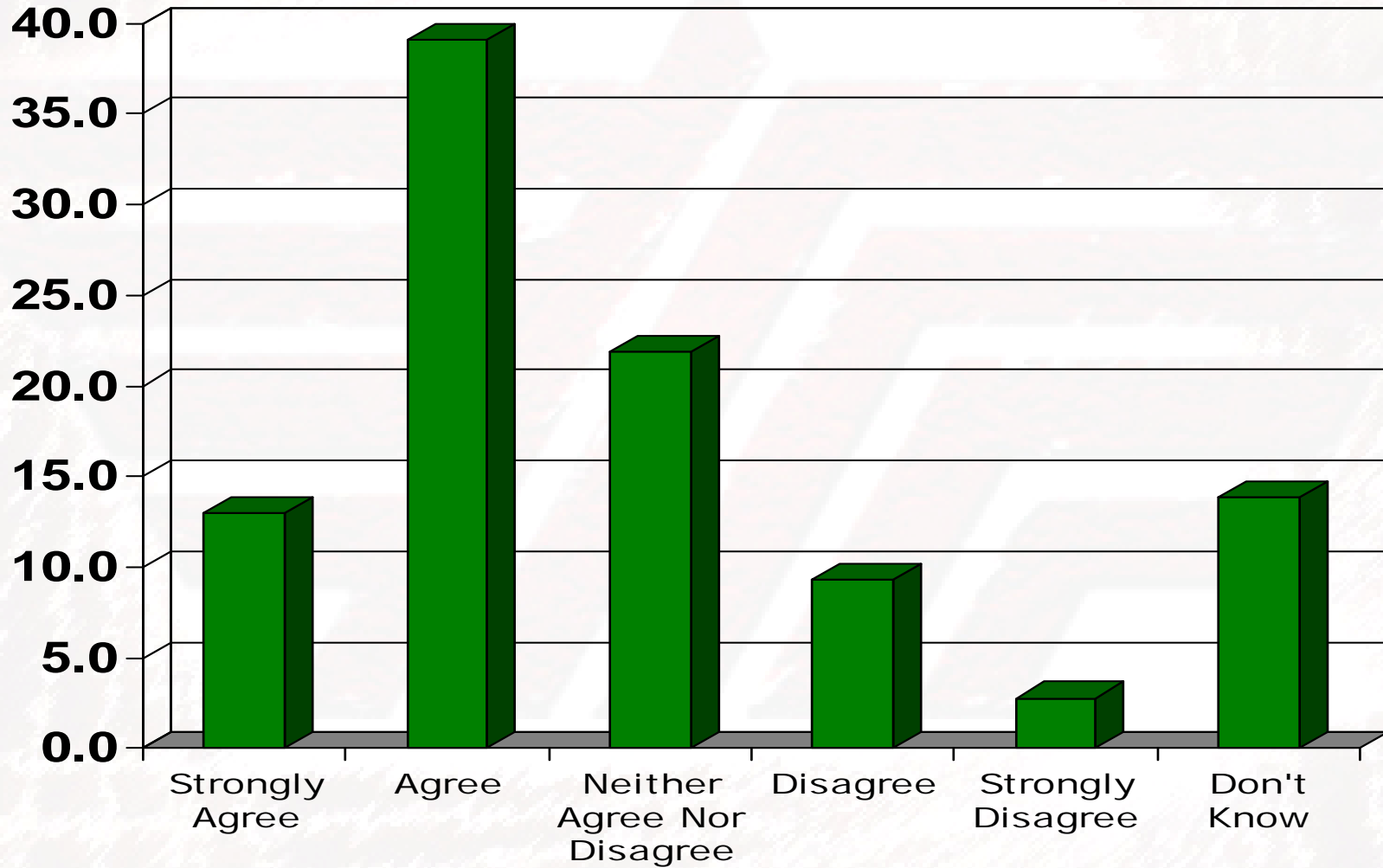
Institutional leaders create an environment for empowerment, innovation, and excellence.



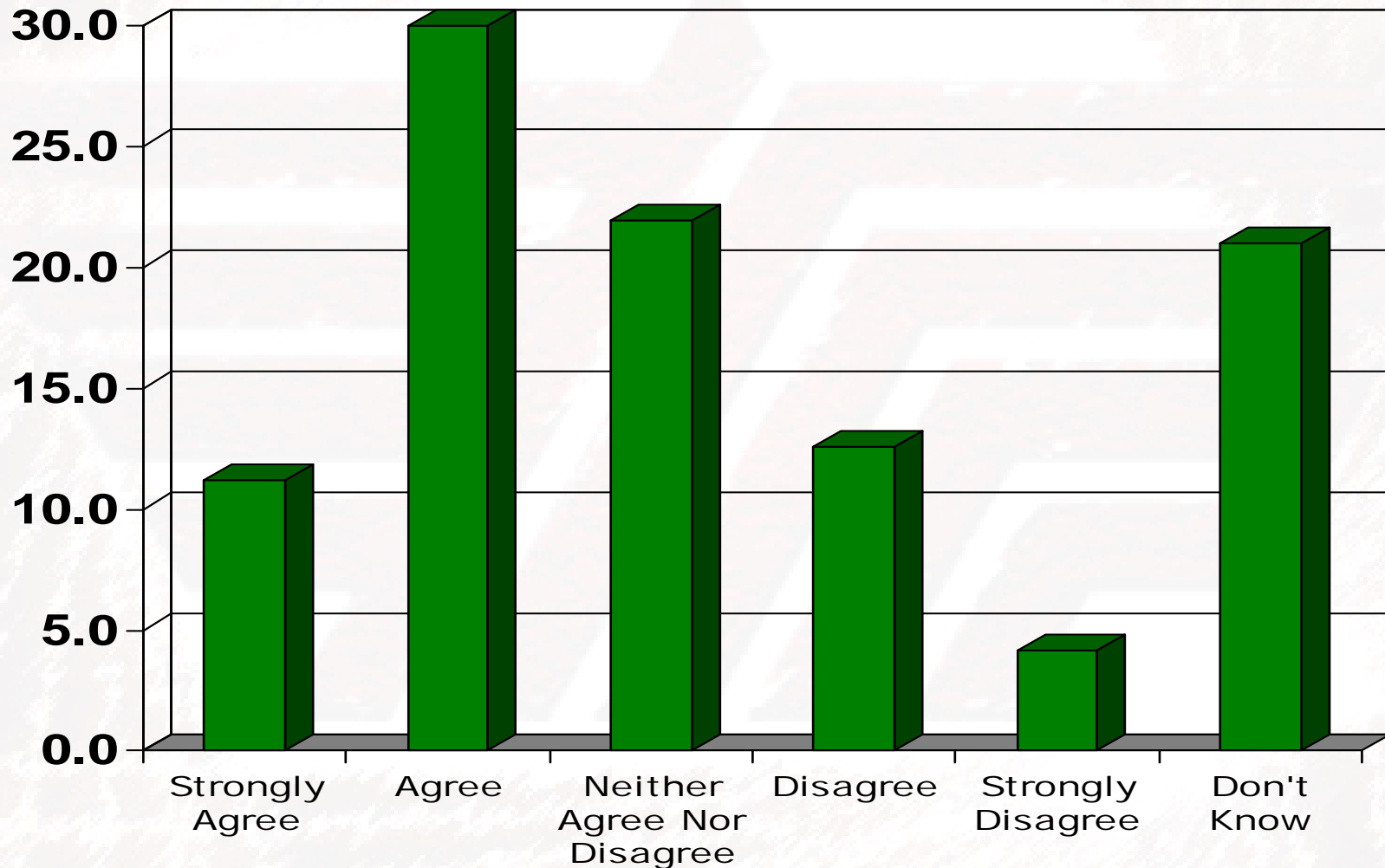
The role of leadership and the institution's governance and decision-making processes are regularly evaluated to assure institutional integrity and effectiveness.



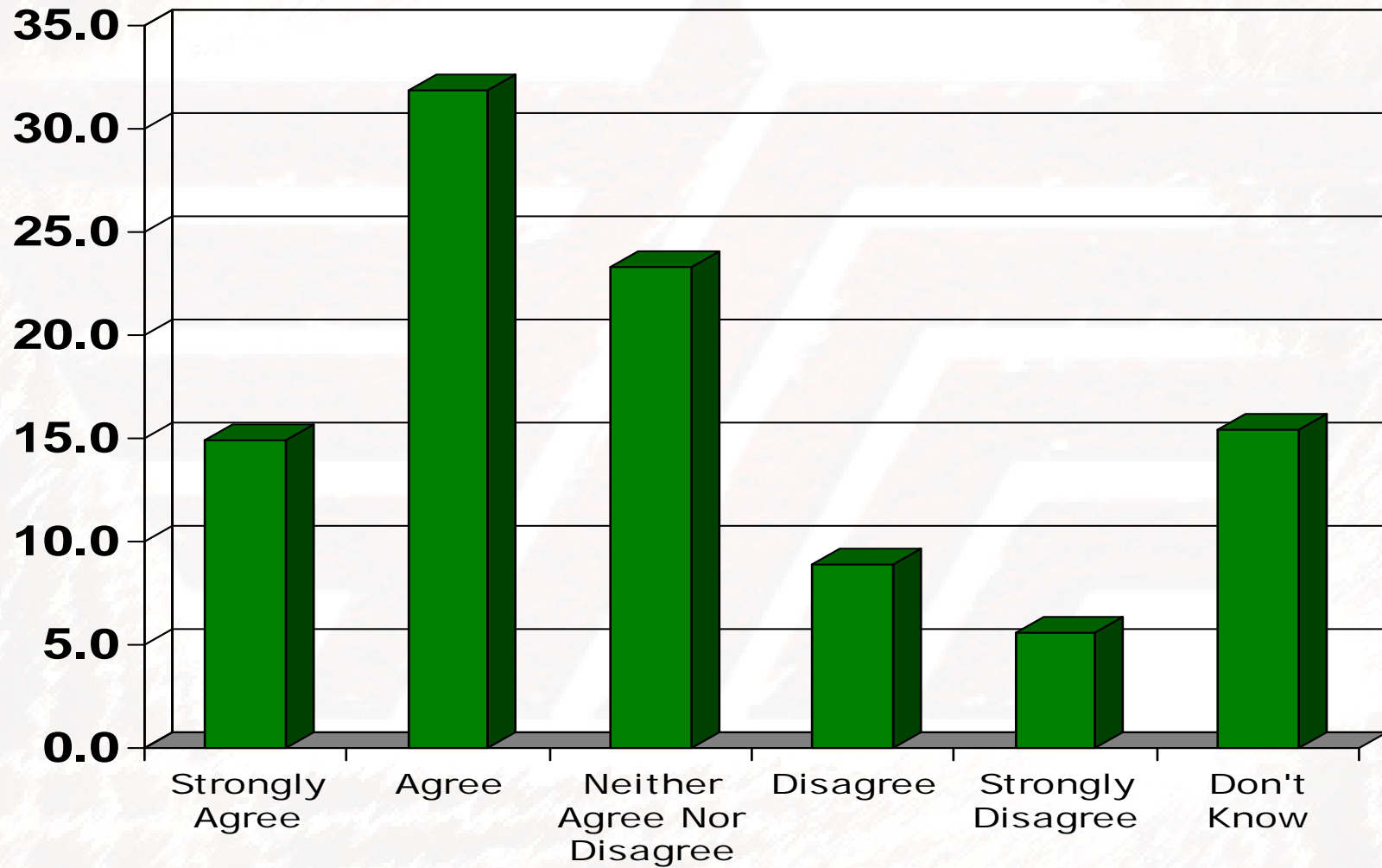
Institutional leaders incorporate a collegial process that sets values, goals, and priorities.

Institutional leaders provide effective and efficient leadership to support the teaching/learning environment.

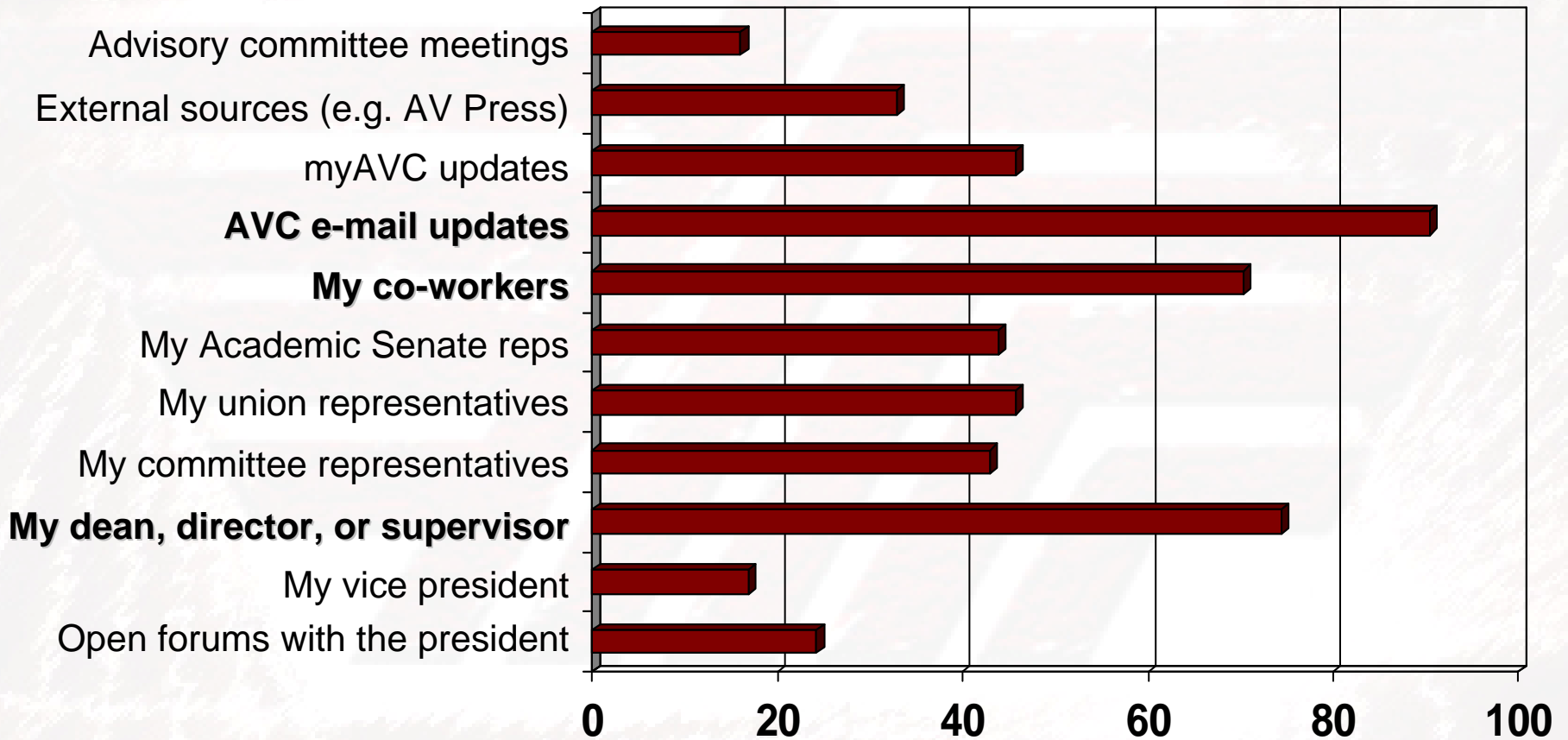
