What we want from early Alert?

Class roster – easily submit requests

Instructor sends students to area

See fi student responds

Counselors, LC, OSD, Equity Mental Health, Food insecure, student Life, (housing, etc.), Veterans, Fin Aid, Previous incarceration, FYE

Canvas Connections, email student + (professor, counselor

Staffing – people to direct alerts.

## Questions, statements, and answers, related to Alert system:

How is BITT different that the Alert system?

Can we default to canvas as a shell? & Use system to advocate, discuss, & administer.

Can a field be added to Banner for faculty to see their roster?

Will instructors only see their own students?

Use self-serve Banner to figure out a way for counselors' access.

What would be the capacity for feedback?

Can a submission be assigned to anyone?

Meeting needed including Crystal Ellis, Equity, Business Services, Network, etc.

Sample of BIT form-system currently appears to already have qualities of the Alert system in discussion.

BIT Care is an Early Alert – for academics.

Diane Flores-Kagan has received Alert for twelve students under B.I.T. Once it is on the systems, student receives a notice. Only 2 responded of the twelve. Participation is voluntary. Only the discipline aspect of B.I.T. is not voluntary.

Can students be contacted via text?

Student phone numbers turnover is high. Phone numbers' in our system are likely outdate. The best way to contact students is via email.

Other colleges have a case manager that receives all the submission forms and takes care of the distribution.
