The Citizens' Oversight Committee

has determined that Measure R funds have been used in full compliance with Article XIIIA of the California State Constitution and for projects identified in Measure R, and that no bond proceeds were used unlawfully for teacher or administrators' salaries.

This annual report to the Board of Trustees is a requirement of Proposition 39. No Measure R bond funds were used for the publication and distribution of this document.

Measure R Financial Summary

Ending balance as of May 26, 2015: \$1,354,317

Audit reports for 2013 and 2014 confirmed that there were no audit findings and that money was spent in compliance with the Measure R bond ballot.
