Palmdale Center

Consider updating IIPP program with current date. Maintaining the document without updating the date creates input or implies the document is obsolete.

The current document states the form was revised October 2001 although sections may have been updated by your organization a cover page should reflect the most recent year.

Palmdale Center study area

Consider attaching Plexiglas partitions to prevent leaning or trip hazards. Prior inspection identified obstructed eyewash - correction made since last inspection

Main campus

Administrative building break room - consider relocating fire extinguisher away from the doorway.

Kitchen appliances observed plugged into one power strip.

Administrative building exit near a A144 mount emergency evacuation documents.

Trip fall hazard torn carpet in office A139.

Trip fall hazard about 21" wide
