II. ACTION ITEMS

3.1 Grant Proposals

The AVC Women Soccer Team (represented by Janelle Skidmore) came to ask for up to \$24 per player, per away games for meal money. There are 23 Soccer players for this proposal. They are playing 7 away games (which are the remaining games for this team, they have played 2 other games).

Moved to approve up to \$3,864 to the AVC Soccer Team by Senator Isaac Grajeda, seconded by Vice President of Academic Affairs Sara Rothenberg. Motion passed 10/0/0.

Dr. Zimmerman brought to the ASO attention that during one of the games that have already been played, coach Jerry Stupak did not submit the paperwork and disregarding the new ASO Grant proposal rules; so he paid for the athlete's lunch out of their own pockets. Therefore, he sought to seek a form of reimbursement from ASO. President Enrique Camacho and Treasurer Patricia Del Gaudio asked where could these funds be paid from, because this could not come out of any particular grant proposal and whether there was a way the district could pay this off somehow. Dr. Zimmerman asked that it could not, however these funds could come from the ASO contingency fund. Coach Stupak stated that due to a miscommunication between his dean and ASO, he was not aware of any changes being made. (Note: an email was sent to him with details on these changes on August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010)

Motion to reimburse Coach Jerry Stupak up to \$299 out of the ASO Contingency fund by Senator Isaac Grajeda. Senator Elaine Tsai seconded the motion. Motion Passes 9/0/1.

### 3.2 Accreditation: Patricia Marquez
