


Q1 Overall, how satisfied are you with the current academic calendar?



Q2 Please rate your overall satisfaction with the semesters of the current academic calendar in helping you achieve your educational goals:









Q3 How desirable is the proposed academic calendar, with its more continuous scheduling and greater capacity to offer sections, for better serving your educational needs?





Q4 How important is it to you that the proposed academic calendar would add 11 weeks of instruction towards more efficient completion of student goals?




