	Introduction	Rumsey	 Guided Pathways is driven by the State in that there is money available for the colleges that participate. The State Chancellor's Office allocated \$150 million dollars available in one-time funds for the implementation of Guided Pathways. The amount available to AVC is approximately \$1.8 million (\$1,781,000). However, to access these funds, there are items that need to be completed within the next five years, as presented on the supporting proposal document sent out by Dean Rumsey. During the meeting, Dean Rumsey presented the Guided Pathways proposal, which is due to the State on March 30th. Due to the Faculty Senate meeting on March 15th, the goal of this committee is to complete the proposal by Monday, March 13th.
