Major Resource Needs (highlights from 2014-2015 Goals and Objectives):

Human Resources (Goal #3) – Increase of full-time assignments (Writing Center Learning Specialist and Reading Tutorial Specialist); filling of vacant position of full-time Academic Skills Learning Specialist and increased funding for adjuncts to resurrect the Early Alert referral process; district line item increased funding for tutors and training (basic skills, CTE, etc.) and hiring of desk assistants.
