VDI – Core Servers Refresh/Upgrading	Dean	Discussion of new server/storage architecture and plans for desktop virtualization: We will be upgrading our hardware/software technology to single units (server/storage housed in one unit, expandable). We spoke with 5 major manufacturers while looking to upgrade to significantly newer technology and seeking a VDI solution for open labs and computer rooms. VDI will allow productivity to occur wherever the user is on campus (i.e. if a lab/room is down, they will see their image in another room/classroom that is working); this will be particularly important as buildings come down over the next month/year.
