		Canvas. It helps faculty create multi-media, and it is ADA
		compliance. The Relay software is easy to use, requires very little
		training, helps with student engagement, and can work with a
		POCR committee. It can be used for evaluations, tests, studying –
		can eliminate lots of pages, binders, etc. Some features include
		being able to record video, upload videos into classes, and there are
		personal libraries for both faculty and students. Quizzes added to
		videos feed grades to Canvas. It also offers analytics that can feed
		directly into Canvas too. Students and faculty can comment on
		videos after posting, students can give critiques/feedback easily.
		Everything is stored on a cloud drive owned by Relay, with no
		storage limits. Canvas treats Relay like an integrated piece. AVC
