		Perry distributed copies of Dr. Beyer's course design review process flowchart. He apologized the chart was not included in the agenda packet. The definition to train needs to be added to the contract in order to set standards. Improvement will come for those involved in training. Deans can advise those online courses that meet the standards will be highlighted by a digital badge and will be better classes.  Dr. Beyer referenced Title 5 language <i>teachers will be prepared to teach</i> ,; a pathway does not infringe on academic freedom. He noted challenges in training of different skill sets. Certain skills must be mastered in order to manage regular and effective contact.
		Dr. O'Neil: advises Social & Behavioral Science adjuncts wanting to teach online to have training through Dr. Beyer. It was suggested Deans justify the instruction necessary for success rates.
		John Toth: online instruction is no different – faculty cannot be mandated to be trained. He referenced 114 community college presidents against online college. The resistance will be the number of hours necessary to complete the training.
		Perry and Dr. Beyer noted how much easier to grade using the rubric. Members agreed the flow works.
		Dr. Beyer will continue with workshops and possibly train on Fall Opening Day.
