III. Opening Comments from Co-chairs	Perry Jehlicka	Call Letter – Class Review Process Perry is communicating with Kristine Oliveira, FPDC Chair, requesting Standard 1 or 2 flex credit, rather than Standard 3.

V. Approval of Minutes	All	A. October 10, 2017 (attachment) A motion was made and seconded to approve minutes from the October 10, 2017 meeting. Changes. Motion carried. Scott Lee – abstained.
VI. Discussion Items	Perry Jehlicka	A. Call Letter - Class Review Process Kristine Oliveira, the Faculty Professional Development Committee Co-chair has approved the Class Review Process for Standard 3 flex credit. Perry is asking for Standard 1 or 2, and



	Perry Jehlicka	will possibly invite Kristine to address DETC for reconsideration. He will get a formal answer from Kristine then will submit the letter for reconsideration if necessary. He will send the draft to members for suggested edits. B. Echo360 Demonstration Representatives presented the Echo360 - a video and active learning platform. The representatives previously had conferences calls with President Knudson and Dr. Suderman for a potential opportunity to get funding to use Echo360 in conjunction with Canvas. The additional support could enhance student success for students from challenged areas. The 3-year pilot would provide funding for licensing, hardware, faculty stipends and classroom enhancement. 750 colleges and universities are using the program worldwide. Echo360 ties directly into LMS. The cloud platform only requires a web browser. Data and security backup is included. The suggested connection is through Canvas, with setup determined by AVC. Fully-optional caption is available, or we can select what we want captioned. Turn around can be or 1 hour – or can take several days.
		A challenge would be getting equipment in the classroom. The pilot would consist of 1,000 students – 8-10 faculty over 3 years, likely teaching in similar classrooms. The organization is working with the Chancellor's office to identify a cursorial campus that would be the lead campus for this. 4-5 have expressed interest. Bakersfield will likely be the campus to manage the program. The representatives will follow-up with Rick Shaw regarding financing.
