Mr. Valiotis talked about news regarding COVID vaccination and the fact that AVC might become a vaccination site. In the event that the vaccination takes place before summer we might be allowed to return on campus for summer and fall 2021. We are still allowed to come on campus for recordings or lab activities but need to let the division know and fill out the self-screening report on the AVC website.

He talked about cuts that needed to be made for summer and the new schedule of 2 6 week blocks and a 12 week one.

Mr. Valiotis talked about the STEM club, and the success of the Engineering Program in collaboration with Long Beach. We had 175 students graduate at AVC with a 100% employment guarantee.

Next we discussed the need to update all AS-T degrees for pathway. We looked at some examples and each discipline will submit their recommended classes to the dean.
