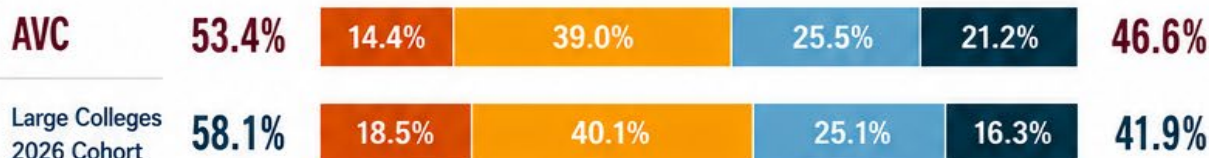


How much has your experience at this college contributed to your knowledge, skills, and personal development in the following areas?

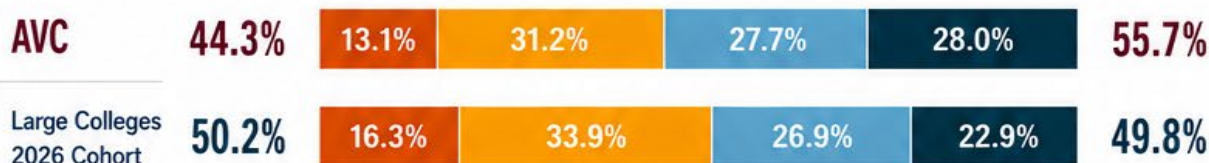

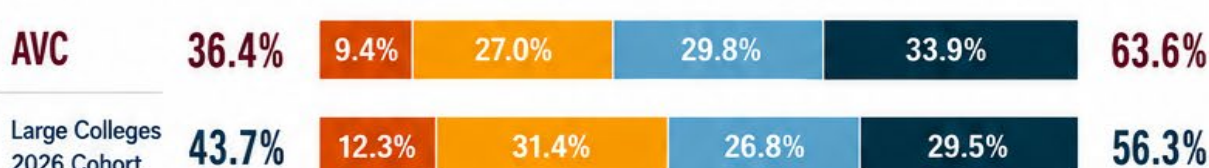

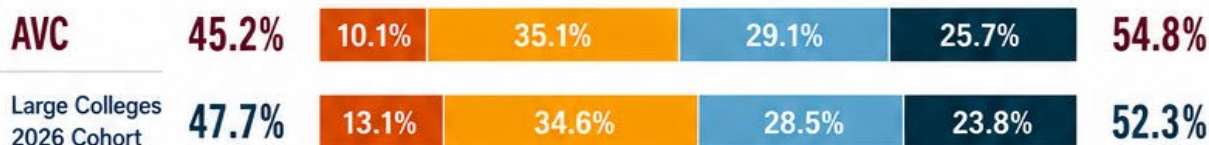

## KEY TAKEAWAYS



AVC students report higher levels of contribution from their college experience in three of five outcomes compared to large colleges.



The largest positive difference is in understanding people from different economic, social, and racial or ethnic backgrounds (+7.3 percentage points).



There is an opportunity to strengthen student perception of contribution to being informed and active citizens.
