## Quarterly Report ending December 31, 2021

Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed by AVCCD to Fall 2021 students under section 2003 (a) (1) of the American Rescue Plan (ARP-HEERFIII) during the reporting period of October 1, 2021 to December 31, 2021 was \$8,505,125 to 8,466 students. During this reporting period 169 grants totaling \$81,550 were returned to AVCCD.

The total ARP Emergency Financial Aid Grants AVCCD has disbursed is \$11,322,250 to 10355 students. There have been a total of 202 grants in the amount of \$97,800 returned to AVCCD, bringing the total funds disbursed to \$11,224,450.

The method used by AVCCD to determine the Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Fall 2021 students under section 2003 (a) (1) of the American Rescue Plan (ARP-HEERFIII) was as follows:

All students with verified profiles, except those incarcerated, were deemed eligible. The minimum grant for Pell eligible students was \$175. The grants were then based on student's enrollment status. Less than half time (>0 and <6 units) received \$350 if Pell eligible. Half time (>=6 and <9 units) received \$950, three quarter time (>=9 and <12 units) received \$1100 and full time (>=6 12 units) received \$1250. Students taking non-credit course received a grant of \$175 if Pell eligible.
