

Quarterly Report ending March 31, 2022

Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed by AVCCD to Spring 2022 students under section 2003 (a) (1) of the American Rescue Plan (ARP-HEERFIII) during the reporting period of January 1, 2022 to March 31, 2022 was \$8,165,275 to 8,042 students. During this reporting period 202 grants totaling \$204,375 were returned to AVCCD.

AVCCD has disbursed a total of 21,334 ARP Emergency Financial Aid Grants totaling \$19,535,575. There have been a total of 404 grants in the amount of \$302,175 returned to AVCCD, bringing the total funds disbursed to \$19,233,400 to 12,126 students.

The method used by AVCCD to determine the Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Spring 2022 students under section 2003 (a) (1) of the American Rescue Plan (ARP-HEERFIII) was as follows:

All students with verified profiles, except those incarcerated, were deemed eligible. The minimum grant for Pell eligible students was \$175. The grants were then based on student's enrollment status. Less than half time (>0 and <6 units) received \$350 if Pell eligible. Half time (>=6 and <9 units) received \$950, three quarter time (>=9 and <12 units) received \$1100 and full time (>=6 12 units) received \$1250. Students taking non-credit course received a grant of \$175 if Pell eligible.
