- Experience as a tennis coach at the professional, college, high school, or club level.
- Experience teaching and/or coaching at a California community college.

Responsibilities:

- Coach and administer the women's tennis program including budget management, maintenance of effective media/public relations, recruitment
 of student athletes, scheduling of contests, supervision of coaching aides, and coordination of all aspects of practice and competition.
- Promote the achievement of academic success by those student athletes participating in the women's tennis program and oversee their involvement in the division's drug screening/education and academic support programs.
