



International Student Admission Requirements

Antelope Valley College is approved by the Department of Homeland Security to accept non-immigrant visa (F-1) international students only.

PROGRAM INFORMATION:

- Must be enrolled as a full-time student (12 or more units) for the Fall and/or Spring Semester(s)
- Must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.00 at all times
- Must report change of address and/or phone number within 10 calendar days to Admission and Records.
- You are not authorized to work off campus. You are eligible to work on-campus after completing your first year in good standing. You must receive permission prior to finding work on-campus, and cannot work more than 20 hours a week.
- Current tuition and fees are due at the time of registration. Beginning Summer 2024, the tuition rate for international students is **\$463 per semester unit**. This includes the \$397 per semester unit cost, \$46 enrollment fee per unit and a Capital Outlay fee of \$20 per unit. (Tuition and fees are subject to change without notice).
- There are no dorms or housing on campus.

REQUIRED ADMISSIONS DOCUMENTS:

- ☐ Go to www.avc.edu and apply online via CCCApply and **keep the application confirmation number**. (List Citizenship = other)
- ☐ International Student Information Form
- ☐ Copy of a valid passport
- ☐ Copy of I-94
- ☐ Applicants can demonstrate English Proficiency by fulfilling one of the following criteria:
 - TOEFL Score to be sent, **directly from the ETS** (AVC ID Code: 4005), with a minimum score of 45 (Internet-based testing) or 450 (Paper-based testing). For test sites and schedules, visit www.toefl.org.
 - IELTS of 5.0. Send an official score report. For test sites and schedules, visit www.ielts.org.
- ☐ High School Diploma and Transcript
- ☐ Current bank statement(s) of the student or local sponsor, showing a minimum balance of US \$22,500.
- ☐ Medical Insurance from a US Agency showing full medical coverage with a minimum of \$250,000 in lifetime medical coverage. (Travel insurance not accepted) **Medical Coverage must be maintained the entire time you are here as a student.**

DEADLINES FOR APPLICATION:

Fall Semester	June 1 st
Spring Semester	November 1 st

Upon approval of all required documents, the AVC Designated School Official will issue an I-20. Any information on this form is subject to change based on regulation changes or cost of living increases. The student and/or sponsor are responsible to cover any adjustments.
