The Learning Center welcomes the thoughtful and ethical use of artificial intelligence (AI) and other emerging technologies when they support student learning. AI can be a useful tool for exploring ideas, asking questions, practicing skills, and receiving additional explanations. However, technology should support—not replace—the critical thinking, creativity, and sustained effort that are essential to learning.

Our goal is to help students develop their own knowledge, skills, ideas, and academic voices while becoming more confident and independent learners. Learning Center faculty, staff, and tutors work collaboratively with students and encourage the use of AI in ways that contribute to intellectual growth rather than doing the learning for them.

Because expectations for AI use vary by course and assignment, the Learning Center respects instructors' individual AI policies. We encourage students to learn and follow their instructors' expectations and to use AI honestly and responsibly.

The Learning Center values the privacy of students and employees. Because the Learning Center is a classroom space, AI-enabled technologies may not be used to record, capture, or share students' study behavior, tutoring conversations, or other visual or audio information without appropriate permission.

When questions arise, we encourage students to talk with their instructor or a Learning Center faculty member. We are here to help students make thoughtful choices about AI while developing the cognitive skills and independence that will serve them beyond the classroom.
