Comments: This section includes meaningful quantitative data (event participation, financial support, survey results) that provides insight into program reach and engagement. However, additional analysis would strengthen the report. Specifically, more explicit discussion of demographic comparisons to AVC's service area and identification of race/ethnicity equity gaps would enhance the equity analysis component. While awareness and engagement gaps are identified, further interpretation of how these relate to specific student populations would strengthen alignment with the guiding questions.

	<p><i>Comments:</i> The section clearly outlines program strengths, including leadership participation, event impact, and financial support provided to students. Challenges are appropriately identified and rated for institutional risk, which strengthens the analysis. Opportunities are logically connected to survey findings. The section would be further enhanced by more explicitly connecting equity gaps to targeted strategies and measurable impact outcomes. Goals listed are actually resource requests, rather student-centered goals. Steps to be taken to achieve the goal and the measure of success are unclear or not provided.</p> <p><i>Comments:</i> Program goals are student-centered and aligned to institutional learning outcomes and ESP goals. Steps to achieve each goal are identified. However, measures of success should be clarified and strengthened to ensure they reflect outcome-based indicators rather than solely activity completion or survey improvement. Additionally, one goal (#4) appears incomplete in the document and may require revision for clarity. Comments: This section provides substantial operational data regarding student outreach, mentoring contacts, and workshop participation. However, deeper analysis of demographic comparisons and identification of race/ethnicity equity gaps would strengthen alignment with the guiding questions. While persistence and completion improvements are referenced, including specific success and retention rate data would enhance the analysis.
