II. Research	Vanessa Escobar & Svetlana Deplazes	 Issue: Presented an AVC student research study about the pandemic. Talking Points: (all) Presenters shared 3 documents. Focused was on "COVID-19 Student Impact Survey Results." Survey disclosed students facing multifaceted challenges. Presenters were asked whether surveyed students in need and their majors could be identified for a possible wellness check-up. Survey dates back to 5/28 – 6/17/2020. Timing is critical to students' state of mind. Survey results may reflect semester-end timing and semester transition dynamics. Survey report predates resources currently and increasingly in place. Report ending on a good note, students were flexible and willing to share their experience. Students expressed having experienced flexibility, help, and understanding from their AVC faculty.
