Total spent is \$5,000. Charles Hood has also submitted a request. They anticipate additional proposals that may be appropriate to fund. Staff Development has \$50,000 for travel.	
III.	Discussion of SPC Planning document, page 11	Ms. Trimble	Ms. Trimble reported she sent the SPC documents to the committee and distributed a copy of Page 11 to attendees, asking they pay attention to the goal and sub-goal. After reviewing, the committee should recommend enhancements She will confirm the timeline and SPC process at the next meeting and send to SPC.

Brainstorming session concerning Summer Bridge programs (See attached)	Dr. Lowry	Attendees broke into small groups for the "Discussion Questions" presented by Dr. Lowry, noting the term "Bridge" is used instead of "Summer Bridge". Ms. Hernandez noted the need to clarify what we mean/define as "Bridge" so that we all have the same definition. A brief discussion followed on how CTE students may benefit, and assistance provided counseling. And, how this may help students be more prepared to "prep then assess"; since there is no apportionment for test prep, they may need to call it something else. It was suggested they get involved with AB288/dual admission.
