45 Day Report - July 9, 2020 Revised August 25, 2020

Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act during the period from May 24^{th*} through July 7^{th*} were disbursed by Antelope Valley Community College District (AVCCD) to 1,099* students in the amount of \$415,410*.

On June 17, 2020, the California Community College Chancellor's Office released a Legal Advisory, 2020-07. This advisory stated that California Community Colleges may immediately disburse emergency financial aid grants to students without regard to a student's eligibility under Title IV of the Higher Education Act or their immigration status.

Using this injunction, AVCCD identified all students that were enrolled in classes on May 26, 2020, were not incarcerated and did not previously receive an Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students. A student's EFC (Expected Family Contribution) was used to determine if a student would be Pell Eligible. If a student was determined to be Pell eligible, they received \$55 per unit, otherwise the amount was \$35 per unit.

Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students, in consideration of the June 17, 2020 injunction, were disbursed to 5,568 students in the amount of \$1,460,365.

To date, Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students were disbursed to 11,875** students in the amount of \$4,420,086.25*.
