

## Antelope Valley College Vendor/Visitor Guidance during COVID

This guidance document is intended to provide specific information for vendors/visitors working on or visiting Antelope Valley College.

All vendors/visitors coming on campus must abide by the following:

- Vendors/visitors must monitor their health daily.
- Do not come to the Antelope Valley College facility if:
  - Your temperature currently or in the past 24 hours has exceeded 100.4° F when measured with a household thermometer.
  - You have signs/symptoms of a fever: sweating, chills and shivering, headache, muscle aches, loss of appetite, irritability, dehydration, general weakness, shortness of breath or cough, loss of smell or taste, and or sore throat within the last 14 days.
  - Anyone in your household has been diagnosed with COVID-19 or has demonstrated COVID-19 symptoms within the last 14 days.
  - You have shared air space for 15 or more minutes over a 24-hour period with anyone outside your home who has a confirmed COVID-19 diagnosis or COVID-19 symptoms within the last 14 days.

- Maintain at least six feet or greater separation when possible; this is everyone's responsibility, but you are ultimately responsible for your own behavior.
- Please review the Antelope Valley College guidelines for wearing a face covering.
  - Strongly recommended indoors at this time.
