ATTENTION: TO ALL FOSTER AND KINSHIP CARE SEMINAR ATTENDEES

We have been having a few problems with the participants not abiding by the following rules. Participant(s) will be dismissed with no credit given should the disruption not be manageable.

- Students are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful manner with students, the instructor and other college personnel.
- Conversations should be confined to class discussion topics.
- Cell phones and pagers must remain off while you are in the classroom. Phone use should be confined to class breaks. (If there is an emergency situation that may require your attention, please bring that to the attention of the instructor).

- Children and other non-students are not allowed in the classroom due to school safety regulations.
- **The instructor has the right to dismiss any participant without any credit given if he or she feels they are not abiding by the rules and disrupting the class.**
