

An Antelope Valley Partnership:







Purpose

 This program is a partnership between Antelope Valley College and the Antelope Valley Union High School District (AVUHSD) to provide AVUHSD high school students the opportunity to enroll in college classes in their high school campus – earning both high school and college credit.



How it works...

 By earning both high school and college credit at the same time, you can complete an associates degree and be ready to transfer in less time- and debt free because tuition and textbooks are included. In addition to your high school resources, you have access to AVC supports services such as the Library and Learning Center.



Course Selection

- A-G High School requirements fulfilled
- General Education (GE) leading toward an AA or AS degree
- IGETC and CSU GE: Certificates of Achievement
- Classes may transfer to a four-year university (not all universities/college will accept Double Up credits)



Student Responsibilities

- College-ready to complete the assigned course work
- Time management skills
- Strong attendance and be an engaged student in class
- Improve organizational skills
- College Ed Plan



Benefits

- College Readiness
- AVC Promise Program upon graduation from high school and you enroll at AVC with 15 units, you will be given priority into the AVC Promise Program which provides free AVC tuition and priority for other AVC support services.
- FREE- tuition and textbooks (Fees include \$1 for Student Representation Fee and \$19 for Student Health Services Fee)
- Working toward an Associates degree
- Impressive on resume, scholarships and college applications



College Services & Resources

- AVC College ID
- Library Services
- Learning Center tutoring and workshops
- Attendance at AVC events such as sports and other campus activities



Next Step: The process

- Complete Double Up Program application by due date, and turn in to your high school counseling office
- Notification of Acceptance by email will be sent shortly after
- If accepted, must complete AVC College Application and Promise Grant Application



Impact of grades for Seniors

- Some classes count as a high school graduation requirement, so students must pass this class to graduate.
- High school= A, B, C, D = passing/ F = no pass and no graduation
- AVC College = A, B, C = passing / D, F no pass and must repeat the course and is a negative mark on permanent college transcripts



LONG-TERM IMPACT

PLEASE REMEMBER: It is vital to remember that these classes are the start of the student's post-secondary career and the grade stays on the record forever.
