Faculty Dept. Meeting

April 14, 2015

- I. Meeting called to order by Dr. Glenn Haller at 6:06pm.
Minutes taken by Brianna Weitz and sign in sheet passed around.

- II. UPDATES:
 1. Kinesiology only Biology/Anatomy is being created. Dr. Joseph Esdin is working on creating a 3.0 unit combo course that would transfer to CSU's.
 2. Bio 201 dedicated to Kinesiology might also be in the works with a specialized lab program that deals with movement in the body. It would work for local degree or certificates but not the AAT degree or toward degrees like Nursing, RADT, or Respiratory.
 3. Constitution: there is a new constitution in the works that is being sent out. It should be in all faculty boxes to review.
 4. Prop-20 budgeting is not part of our expertise, but it is good for us to know the budget for our own use. If there are any suggestions on materials to purchase for the classes then a list should be submitted to Glenn and then passed on to the Department Buyer.
 5. Courses for revision: A list was sent out on what courses should be revised. They need to be revised by August/September of this year. The updates should be complete along with the addition of the course assessments.
 6. KIN 100 *Introduction to Kinesiology* (3)
Course does not focus on the lifelong understanding and development of students as integrated physiological, social and psychological beings to the extent required for Area E. Appears to be more focused on career development.
 7. Local degree changes: the degree is not really working for us right now. There have been discussions on changes that should be made. If we had an AAT and other local program, about 90% of students would be able to advance and transfer. Yoga Instructor Degree is still in the process and Kathy Bingham is waiting to hear back.

III. Equivalencies:

1. The Committee has approved the two courses with no changes. There were problems with the Tourism and Recreation Course with regards to instruction. They had an issue with an instructor having a Master's in Tourism. That has been removed from that section and there has been an addition of Bachelor's in recreation or tourism. Please see Appendix A for example.

IV. SLO/PLO/ACTION PLANS:

1. Everyone needs to have SLO data in by June. HE 101 was already turned in for Fall 2014. Both Semesters are required each year but it only needs to be updated once a year. The instructors must make sure that all SLO's match for each course, but the testing for SLO can be tested in a format chosen by the instructor. The assessments must also be similar in content to each other.
2. Action plans are due in August. Go into the program review for decision making.
3. PLO's still need to be done as well.

V. CERTIFICATE/ DEGREE PROGRAMS/2 UNIT COURSES:

1. Right now we are unsure of how to continue with this area. Coaching and Athletic training need to be worked on. If there are any suggestions please come forward with your ideas.
2. Two-Unit courses are not written yet. We need to decide on how to complete them: Are we going to use "families" or do Beginning with Theory/Analysis. A suggestion was to incorporate Beginning and Intermediate combined with an advanced/ theory overlay so that it can be taken multiple times by students. This was discussed briefly but not decided. It was also suggested to have an hour of lecture time with three hours of lab/activity time. This was also not further discussed. Next meeting everyone is to bring examples of two-unit courses. There is a possibility of these courses being assigned to instructors for future completion.

VI. CLASS SCHEDULING:

1. Spring of 2016 is currently being worked on. Please submit any changes that you might have or wants/needs for the future. If there are courses that you want/don't want please let Glenn know ASAP.
