## **SLO** Assessment Demonstration

Major or minor revisions affects the course. Some still need to get assessments into WEAVE for 2010-11 and the cycle is timing out. Assessment data for summer should go into the 2010-11 cycle. Remember, you can access WEAVE from home and do Action Plans.

# How to access action plans

- 1) go to assessment tab in WEAVE
  - then measures and findings
  - will see manage related action plans
  - a) first button add relationships
    - if you check box, all SLOs tie together, type in once and will show up on all SLOs
- 2) Under assessment tab click on Action Plan Tracking will take back to Add Action Plan section

#### **PLOs**

Fifty percent of PLOs have been approved and more are going forward. These also need to be in WEAVE. Not using Goals or Mission/Purpose, use Outcome and Objectives. Add outcome try for only 1-3 per program. Put into WEAVE software only in Mastery courses.

Follow up Accreditation report due next fall and all SLOs must be at proficiency level 100%.
