Course Description

This course is designed to provide students with an introductory overview of the Media Arts field including print, illustration, typography, digital photography, video/ audio, interactive media (web design, CD/ROM, DVD), animation, and game design. Students will be introduced to industry standard computer hardware and software (such as Adobe's Illustrator, Photoshop and InDesign, terminology, as well as operating systems, design principles, and career paths.

Lab Hours

Each student is required to complete a total of 24 hours of lab time which must be completed in APL 203. The lab is graded on Pass/No Pass. You must complete the entire 24 hours of lab to pass the lab.

Participation and Attendance

Attendance and class participation is mandatory. Participation includes being on time, class discussions and assignments. If you miss a class you are responsible for getting the information that you may have missed. If you come in late or have to leave early please let me know, otherwise you will be marked absent for the day. Three absences will result in being dropped from the course. However, if you choose to stop attending the course it is your responsibility to drop the course. Otherwise you may receive an "F" in the course.
