LAC 900 CORs, SLOs, Assessment, Action Plans

Quantitative assessment: Data from tutoring reports. Discussion about accuracy of tutor ratings of tutees, random collection, tracking, disclaimer for Math Center usage and tutoring data, DLAs for tutoring, testimonials for qualitative measures, methods to assess in-class tutors and students they tutor, and the need to create a uniform culture of tutoring on campus that involves categorical Student Services entities (EOPS, STAR). Agreement that no change in the current assessment method will be made at this time. *SLO targets met*. Action plans: Tutor training scenarios using metacognitive measures, toolbox for tutor feedback in tutoring sessions.

LAC 901 CORs, SLOs, Assessment, Action Plans

Quantitative assessment: Data from learning outcomes surveys. Discussion about the effectiveness of outcomes surveys. *SLO targets met*. Action plans: Future faculty retreats when all can be present, emphasis on defining study skills in the ILIP and workshop and demonstrating one resource for students to identify.

LC OOs, Assessment, Action Plans

Quantitative assessment: LC computer and website usage, web-based resource usage, four promotional activities each term (fall and spring). Discussion about accreditation and LC data, the need for faculty to better understand connections. *OO targets met*. Action plans: Comparisons of student owned equipment with LC computer usage, promote LC to categorical student services programs via workshops and other services.
