



Strategic Priorities 2026-2027 – 2028-2029

AVCCD Board of Trustees

Upon reviewing data indicating progress toward the accomplishment of the 2025-2026 Strategic Priorities and Goals, the Antelope Valley College Board of Trustees established these Strategic Priorities and Goals for the next three academic years. Each year, the Board of Trustees will review data exemplifying institutional progress toward the goals and affirm successive targets and priorities.

Priority 1: FTES and Enrollment (aspirational target in parenthesis)

Goal 1a: Increase FTES by 8% (10%) annually

Baseline: 11,126 FTES

2026-2027: 12,016 (13,128)

2027-2028: 12,977 (14,440)

2028-2029: 14,015 (15,884)

Goal 1b: Increase Enrollments by 10% annually (12%)

Baseline: 98,501 Enrollments

2026-2027: 108,351 (110,321)

2027-2028: 119,186 (123,559)

2028-2029: 131,104 (138,386)

Priority 2: Completion of Math and English in the First Year

Goal: Increase Completions by 5% annually

Baseline: 19%

2026-2027: 19.2%

2027-2028: 20.2%

2028-2029: 21.3%

Priority 3: Job Placement Rates – All areas above 70% placement

Goal 3: Increase the number of CTE awards earned by 5%

Baseline: 408 CTE program awards

2026-2027: 428

2027-2028: 449

2028-2029: 471

Priority 4: Community Outreach, Participation, and Involvement

Goal 4: Increased Community Outreach, Participation, and Involvement

Measured by Information from All Areas:

Outreach Activities and Attendance; Participation in Community Organizations; Meetings and training hosted; Presentations for Community Organizations; Events Hosted
