## QUESTIONS SUBMITTED FOR RFP No. AVC2014/2015-24 ATHLETIC FIELD REPAIR PROJECT

- Q: For bonding purposes, what is the estimated budget for the project?
- A: Estimated budget is no greater than \$50,000
- Q: Under the FCCC purchasing contracts we have for both indoor and outdoor surfacing. This FCCC is specifically for you and Community Colleges so you don't need to go out to bid.
- A: The RFP is for the <u>repair</u> of our track, not necessary the purchase of supply/product, which could allow a district to utilize the FCCC contract. However, please see section 4 under Notice of Bidders (Contractor shall have a current CMAS contract for any needed additional product). The construction component for the track makes this a public project and subjects it to the competitive bidding requirements of Public Contract Code section 20651, subdivision (b). Therefore, we cannot piggyback on the actual repair/installation work.
- Q: The RFP says that a B license in required. Is there a reason for this? The scope of work that I see does not require a B license.
- A. Upon further review, it has been identified that a Bidder does not necessary require a "B" License. A Bidder must demonstrate they are properly licensed by California Contractor State License Board, in addition to being an authorized & certified Mondo installer. See Addendum No. 1.
