1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

A motion was made and seconded to call the April 14, 2011 AP&P Committee Meeting to order at 3:10 p.m. Ms. Maria Clinton, AP&P Faculty Co-Chair, called the meeting to order at 3:10 p.m. Motion carried.

2. OPENING COMMENTS FROM THE COMMITTEE CO-CHAIR

Ms. Maria Clinton wanted to clarify that the AP&P Representatives are not responsible for fielding faculty questions regarding the Student Learning Outcomes (SLO). It is imperative that those responsible for producing SLOs seek out the help of the SLO Committee so that no confusion occurs regarding the appropriate process. Several SLOs are still outstanding as stated at the bottom of this agenda. Ms. Clinton requested the AP&P Representatives to simply report this list to their division dean and faculty.

Ms. Maria Clinton also wanted to make clear the fact that the AP&P Representatives are responsible for guiding their division faculty through the CurricUNET process as was the case when the paper documents were being utilized. She stated that several faculty have been enlisting the help of Mrs. Melissa Jauregui, however the AP&P Representatives should be the first point of contact for all CurricUNET related questions since Mrs. Jauregui cannot answer questions related to curriculum.

Ms. Maria Clinton stated that due to a majority vote this item will be sent to the Senate and subsequently the Board of Trustees for a formal approval to be added in the 11-12 College Catalog.

6. DISCUSSION ITEMS

a. **Mission Statement**

Ms. Maria Clinton stated that the mission statement is reviewed annually by this committee and requested the committee take a look at the mission statement, which is included in this packet. The AP&P Representatives are to take this information back to their division faculty for review and revision. This item will return to the AP&P agenda on May 12, 2011 at which point the AP&P Representatives will report from their divisions.

b. **Reading, Mathematics, and Writing Proficiency levels of Students upon Graduation**

Mrs. Sharon Lowry stated that the process for reviewing student's Reading, Mathematics, and Writing Proficiency levels is not well defined. Ms. LaDonna Trimble elaborated on the process, stating that the Graduation Office and Admissions and Records use the language as stated in the college catalog in comparison to the student transcripts to determine whether or not the proficiency levels have been met prior to the award of a degree/certificate. The only variation that is allowed is when a student takes a course that has a built in reading component. The language in the catalog for the Reading Proficiency seems problematic due to the mention of the student's ability to receive a "P" in lieu of a grade. Dean, Maggie Drake stated that it maybe beneficial to investigate the procedures and levels of other colleges so to not reinvent the wheel, and return to the AP&P Committee with a recommendation based on common practice. Dr. Lee Grishman recommended that English and Reading be completely separate in lieu of allowing a student to apply a reading component from another course.

Mrs. Maria Clinton asked the committee to look at the material for this new degree, which appears in the agenda packet. Ms. Clinton stated that this will be the second transfer degree that we have been presented with for inclusion in the 11-12 College Catalog. Dr. Les Uhazy, Dean of Math, Science and Engineering, stated that some minor changes had been made to the language but the meaning is still the same. Ms. Maria Clinton asked the committee if they would like this to return with the most up-to-date information. The committee decided to approve the document with stated changes to the first page. A motion was made and seconded to approve the AS-T in Mathematics. Motion carried as revised.
