

Hello, Math Summit attendees—

The LACCD Math Summit is upon us and will take place this Friday, March 11th, from 9:30 AM to 2:30 PM at LA Trade Technical College. We are very pleased that so many are interested in attending and we have re-arranged the logistics for the event so that everyone who registered (including everyone on the waiting list) will have a space at the event.

In order to accommodate everyone, we added an additional room right next door to the main assembly room that will be linked to the main room via videoconference. The expansion room is actually a lecture hall with stadium-style seating in comfortable, upholstered chairs. Visibility of the speakers in that room may actually be better than in the main room, where the folding chairs will be placed on a flat floor. There will be more than enough space to accommodate all participants in the breakout rooms where the hands-on work will be done.

Parking for this event is in the parking structure located at Washington and Grand (entrance from Olive Ave). Parking is free and no permits are needed for this one day only. From the parking garage, walk south on Grand Ave (away from downtown) towards 23rd St. Sign in for the Math Summit will be in the tent behind the TE building, where you will be given conference materials and can have some of the morning refreshments beginning at 8:30 AM. Conference packets will be color coded so that those who registered first will be admitted to the main presentation room and later registrants will be admitted to the overflow room. By 9:30 AM you will proceed to the room indicated on your conference packet for the plenary sessions. Participants may choose which of the many breakout sessions to attend; all breakout rooms are close to the main presentation rooms. Lunch will be served in the outside tent at 12:30. Please see the attached campus map for locations of the parking structure, sign-in and food tent, and the TE building. The address of LA Trade Tech College is 400 West Washington Blvd, Los Angeles 90015 for those who need specific driving instructions. Please note that there is significant construction in the area, so leave plenty of time to navigate around the construction zones.
