	<ul> <li>effectiveness, AVC joined OEI, a faculty handbook is being generated, faculty certification is being implemented, moved from Blackboard to Canvas, Dr. Beyer offered bootcamps to help faculty learn and improve on their online classes, established a POCR committee for accreditation. There is date to show that these efforts are successful – Perry directed the committee to a website with this data. New funding sources will want to see proof that it's working before agreeing to help support it. What are we doing to help students with online classes? DETC is focused on helping faculty. Quest – can be linked in online classes and included with the agenda/curriculum for classes. "Getting started" type test/quiz. Online Readiness quiz is there too, but it can't be "required."</li> <li>B. Distance Education Handbook – further discussion? No. All committee members are happy with current handbook.</li> <li>C. POCR – a plan is being created with some good starting points. No more than 5 classes will be reviewed at one time, 2-3 week window, none will be reviewed at mid-terms or finals. About 10 hours to review one class. Dr. Brynin would like to join the POCR committee and will take the training course during the summer. It's suggested to take one of your own classes through the POCR process, to see both sides of the system. Each class will be broken down into categories to help split it between each POCR member for review. POCR members will not be critiquing classes. A chance in the POCR rubric is coming soon. Greg Bormann will send out a link to the committee for a webinar on these changes. Guided pathways funds are being considered to help fund this as well as Student Equity. Dr. Beyer asked about the Corona Virus and possible campus closures – ITS is working on plans to help faculty, staff and students with the possible transition to online work/study.</li> <li>D.
