VI. Discussion Items	A. Yuja Video Presentation – Steven Pace presented on a product to potentially replace Knowmia. Currently AVC is under contract with Knowmia, they will be going out of business in the spring semester 2022. Yuja automatically captions the video made when it goes into the library. The captions run about 95% accuracy and will get better as a person uses the Yuja video. The person can also add words to a personal dictionary. The faculty can upload documents as well, such as YouTube, audio, pdfs, they are more flexible with this than Knowmia is. The process is drag and drop very simple to use. Yuja, can also be used with foreign languages, it does not translate



	<p>though. Yuja also does many of the technologies that are used in Camtasia. They will provide the campus training, those that have admin right, faculty, they also have support for students. Yuja, can be used as a quiz tool as and will go to the Canvas gradebook. Yuja integrates very well with canvas our campus LMS. The instructor can share video straight from their video library. This allows the faculty to collaborate better. The technology will also allow the instructor to edit captions as needed. This can be used as a proctoring tool as well but that is an added service from the video recording and captioning. Quizzes and different types of assessments can be easily built into the video as a way to assess the students. The video will stop when the student gets to a question and when they answer the question they can advance in the assessment. Analytics will be provided from the view and assessments for the instructor. Support can be done through email, chat, toll free number, video tutorials. This is available for everyone, faculty, students and administration. They are willing to give some test accounts out to those that would like to try the service.</p> <p>B.
