Your stated goal of increasing retention needs to begin by documenting a benchmark retention rate for this academic year, or past year(s) if you have that information, and then continue tracking retention data to see if the retention rates of CalWORKs students improve in subsequent years. Please also consider tracking the annual number of CalWORKs students who

complete certificate and degrees. You are documenting the services but not their impact.

You will be asked in future self-study reports to cite examples of using action plans that resulted in or correlated with improved outcome findings. You left that blank in this report (Part 3). Please be ready to show in your next report where an OO action plan was executed and resulted in improved OO findings.

Comments to the program:
