Comments about the self-study report:

This area, guided by EMP goals e.g., #5 & #7, as well as its own area goals, has been working diligently to improve its services. This is partially due to the requirements of the SSSP and partially as an effort to continuously improve processes related to admissions, graduation, transcripts, and assessment of students. The Enrollment Services area regularly gathers input from its primary stakeholders-students and uses that information to modify services as needed. The students appear to be generally satisfied and where they aren't as satisfied, the area works to address their concerns e.g. increased automation of transcript process.

Recommendations to the program:

The consequential validity procedure previously used at AVC and the appropriate placement of students needs improvement to support rigor, validity and reliability. Continue to work with assessment personnel and faculty to address this for more accurate placement of students.
