**Please note:** The ILOs were approved by AVCCD Board September 14, 2015, measures are still a draft.

\*Under measures, examples are given as possibilities of the Learning Outcomes or CCSSE answers which could be determined to be used for assessment of the particular ILO. The various programs would make determination what exactly to use.

When making these determinations these rules of thumb should be used when establishing and connecting SLOs, PLOs to ILO(s):

- •Each program need NOT fulfill every Institutional Outcome;
- •Each course within a program need NOT fulfill every program learning outcome;
- •Each course must meet at least one of its program's established student learning outcomes;
- •A course should meet every one of its stated student learning outcomes.
