



Strategic Priorities 2026-2027

Based upon the Board of Trustees' Strategic Priorities and Goals for 2026 – 2029, the President has established the following goals for the Academic Year 2026-2027. Each year, the Board of Trustees will review institutional progress toward the goals and affirm successive targets and priorities for relevance and challenge. There are two goals listed for the priorities, one at 8% and one at 10%. The discussion about the range of targets centered on the idea that continual growth will reach a saturation point; however, given the range of opportunity before Antelope Valley College, there is time for continued growth, expansion, and improvement.

Priority 1: FTES and Enrollment

Goal 1a: Increase FTES by 8% (10%) annually

Baseline: 11,126 (to be updated upon finalization of 25-26)

2026-2027: 12,016 (13,128)

Goal 1b: Increase Enrollments by 10% (12%) annually

Baseline: 98,501

2026-2027: 108,351 (110,321)

Priority 2: Completion of Math and English in the First Year

Goal: Increase Completions by 5% annually

Baseline: 19%

2026-2027: 19.2%

Priority 3: Job Placement Rates – All areas above 70% placement

Goal 3: Increase the number of CTE awards earned by 5%

Baseline: 408 CTE program awards

2026-2027: 428

Priority 4: Community Outreach, Participation, and Involvement

Goal 4: Increased Community Involvement

Measured by Outreach Activities and Attendance; Participation in Community Organizations; Meetings and trainings hosted; Events and Presentations Hosted

Priority 5: Increase percentage of Full-time Students

Goal 5: Increase percentage of Full-time Students by 5% annually

Baseline: 31.3%

2026-2027: 36.3%
