Term

I was asked by a faculty member to look at the percent of withdrawals from fall 2005 through fall 2009. On average, the terms have 2816 overall average of withdrawals with fall with 4969 per term, winter intersession with 212 per term, spring with 5083 per term, and summer with 999 per term. The data below indicates there is a decrease in withdrawals in fall by 3.7%, winter intersession by 0.8%, spring by 0.8%, and summer by 0.6%. As the student, population increases the level of increased retention with the limited amount of classes offered.

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

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Research for: Student Success and Equity

The research was requested was as an update to the Student Success and Equity report. The study followed the transfer rate on a cohort within a six-year window. The trend shows increased transfer rates in African American students by 10%, Filipino students by 3%, Unknown students by 14% and White non-Hispanic students by 7%. The trend also shows a decrease in Asian students by 16%, and Hispanic students by 2% between the three cohort year groups.
