		ENGL 102 PUENTE Honors Proposal:
		Presented by Bianca Ascencio. Honors option includes an independent research project where students will write a paper on the impact of colonization on indigenous civilizations. Project requires independent research, the use of primary and secondary sources, and a presentation of the findings. Biweekly meetings with the instructor are required. Project will allow students to explore their cultural heritage and develop their critical thinking skills.

Discussion: English 102 Honors is already approved and is transferable to the UC's. Classes should parallel one another.

John Vento asks for clarification that this is an honors option and not a separate course proposal. Research is separate from what is required in the non-honors option of the course. Also mentions possible re-evaluation of the due date to the end of week 12/13.

Rachel Jennings suggests cutting back on the number of assignments so that they are not due each week.

Gregg Langner suggests adding a presentation and notes that the course should align with ENG 102 Honors.

Honors student mixer: When should it be held? Mid-spring semester. Poll faculty for availability. Two possible options: the week before or week after spring break. Poll will be sent to honors and honors option faculty to see which day works best.

Subject Areas Awards memorandum: Goal was to send this week. Vanessa Escobar currently working on generating a student list for faculty to use to make sure the nominated student qualifies. A memorandum will not be sent until after list is complete. Darcy: "Save the date" email to remind faculty that the subject awards are coming and when the due date is for awards submission is (March 22nd). Jedidiah has created a new scoring rubric that can be distributed to faculty.

Note: Crossover between subjects: many students will receive nominations from faculty in different subjects due to overlap in degree requirement.

Possible follow up: Should extracurriculars be added to the scoring rubric?

Informational Item: Nominations must be submitted to the department admin and dean. Faculty are now responsible for checking to make sure that students qualify.
